- ❖ **The Hawai'i Convention Center donates surplus food to Harbor House.**
Harbor House is a non-profit, all volunteer organization that distributes and delivers food to feed the less fortunate families on O'ahu. Harbor House is partnered with the Hawai'i Food Bank who is a certified member of America's Second Harvest and operates the official food bank in the State of Hawai'i
- ❖ **The Hawai'i Convention Center recycles food waste with Ecofeed.** Ecofeed processes the food waste into animal feed.
- ❖ **The Hawai'i Convention Center recycles: paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and aluminum.**
- ❖ **The Hawai'i Convention Center features biodegradable and compostable disposable ware.**
 - **Ecotainer™ Hot Beverage Cups** – made from fully renewable resources, sustainable wood fiber and corn and is biodegradable and compostable.
 - **GREENWARE™ Cold Beverage Cups** – made from NatureWorks™ Poly Lactic Acid (PLA), a resin derived entirely from natural corn materials. PLA is 100% renewable through annual corn harvests and is biodegradable and fully compostable.
 - **Biodegradable FDA Plastic Cutlery**
 - **Disposable Napkins** – made from 100% recycled fibers and are biodegradable and compostable.
 - **EATware™ Hot Bowls** – made from a combination of bamboo, rice, sugarcane and willow fibers held together by EATplus™, an organic additive. And clear bowl covers are made from corn plastic.
 - **World Centric Plate Lunch Clamshells** – a biocompostable product made from residual sugar cane fiber.
 - **Eco Products Sandwich Clear Clamshell** – produced with plastic manufactured from domestic plants instead of petroleum. All are BPI certified compostable with zero waste.
