

6 paid internships through the Student Sustainability Internship Program (SSIP) to create a milestone program with the Department of Education right here in Hawaii!

Any student in the University of Hawaii system may apply, and you will be trained and mentored so you don't need to have experience, you just need to have a genuine interest and curiosity! I will personally mentor an interdisciplinary team of six student interns from diverse areas throughout the University of Hawaii system such as engineering, architecture, education, psychology, economics, and education. The team will receive training in energy star auditing, waste auditing, LEED for existing buildings, report writing, data collection and more! You will work 15 hours per week during the Spring 2010 semester and the exact schedule will be determined by the availability of the six students. The interns will be trained and mentored to research methodologies and perform a sustainability assessment of Keone'ula school in Ewa beach. This will include water, energy and waste-stream baseline measurements and recommendations. Transportation will be provided. They will also mentor the Keone'ula students to participate in activities appropriate to their skills and age. This process is intended to serve as a template for the development of a program which will facilitate sustainability assessments throughout the DOE using the model of SSIP student interns mentoring DOE students. The project will run from Mar.1 - June 18, 2010 with possible rehire for subsequent semesters. Minimum qualifications include the proven ability to work well in a team, understanding of energy conservation and efficiency, a genuine interest in sustainability, ability to interact with children in grades K-6, basic MS word and excel skills.
